ANNOUNCEMENT

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

The **Talveunistus Cup 2024** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, and the relevant ISU Communications as well as the classification of the Estonian Skating Union for season 2023/2024.

Participation in the **Talveunistus Cup 2024** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

However, the OC can have a final design about over-quota for any club/country/ federation or refuse to accept the entry (full or partially).

ENTRIES:

All Entries to the **Talveunistus Cup 2024** must be submitted using official forms. The forms have to be sent to the OC by e-mail: talveunistus@talveunistus.planet.ee

The deadline for entries is 16.03.2024

NB! Changing categories for skaters is not allowed after deadline for entries! Please note, that any replacements in entry form has to be made into the same class and category. Please note, that any replacements in entry form has to be made before 25.03.2024!

ENTRY FEES:

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

- 50€** - per single skater in **Artistic** category
- 80€** - per single skater with one(1) program
- 90€** - per single skater with two(2) programs

The entry fee will not be refunded after the deadline in case of withdrawals for any reason.

Notice: All Entry Fee payments received **after 23:59 local time, march 16th, 2024** are subject to **late entry fee of 10€** per single skater. The late entry fee is not applicable only if a Member Federation or Club is substituting a skater, whoes entry fee was paied by the deadline by another skater. The OC reserves right to cancel Entry of skaters whoes entry fee has not been payed by the published deadline.

Each club has to pay for its participants 100% of the total amount right after the entry form confirmation, by **16.03.2024**

PLANED PROGRAM CONTENT:

The "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee before 16.03.2024. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be completed precisely by each skater in English using the proper terminology.

MUSIC:

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

the participating member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (talveunistus@talveunistus.planet.ee)
Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s).

Example:

EST_Chicks_Boys_FS_Smith_John
LAT_Senior_Women_SP_Maxwell_Max

the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.

Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when re-produced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.

RESULTS:

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used. Result information and detailed protocols will be available on our website: talveunistus.planet.ee

AWARDING:

The three best-placed competitors in each event will be awarded with a medal. All competitors will receive a diploma.

EXPENCES:

All participants and teams must pay the accommodation and transportation themselves.

ACCOMMODATION:

The Organizers shall not arrange accommodation.

TIME SCHEDULE:

Preliminary time schedule will be published soon after the close of entries and it will be available on our website: talveunistus.planet.ee

DRAW:

An electronic draw will take place on 28.03.2024, starting orders will be published on our website: talveunistus.planet.ee. There will not be a draw after short programs. Starting order for free programs will be according to inverse of the results of short programs.

THE CODE OF ETHICS:

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU Communication 2478, (or any update of this Communication). Action against this rule conducts by itself the disqualification of the skater.

RESPONSIBILITY:

In accordance to ISU Constitution, rule 119, all participants act at their own responsibility.
